



Writing for Humanities

Humanities encompasses these fields offered at GMC: Art, Communications, English, Foreign Language, Music, and Theater.

Art: Writing about visual content

This involves writing about these types of visual content:

Paintings	Architecture	Sketches
Sculptures	Crafts	Computer graphics
Drawings	Graphic design	Clothing design

...and much more

Communications: Writing about communication

This involves writing speeches of your own and writing about other forms of communication:

Speeches	Media campaigns	Movies
Plays	Songs	

English: Writing in composition classes

This involves writing creative works of your own and writing essays on various topics and about literature:

Short stories	Poems
Plays	Novels

Foreign Language: Writing about communication of a foreign language

This involves learning to write in a language other than English and writing about different cultures. Foreign languages offered at GMC are French, Spanish, and German.

Music: Writing about Music

This involves the following types of writing assignments:

Concert report	Performance or media comparison
Historical analysis	Argumentative paper on a musical composition, artist, genre, etc.
Song analysis	

Theater: Writing about Theater

This involves writing about the different areas of theater, such as plays, productions, and performances, and writing about theatrical periods, techniques and criticism.

Paper Format: Formatting Essays for Humanities

Do not assume all classes will use MLA format! Common formats are MLA, APA, and Chicago.

*Begin any paper by carefully reviewing the directions. *Remember skills learned in ENG 101.
